ANTH 170. Physical Anthropology and Archeology

ANTH 171. Introduction to Cultural Anthropology

This course explores key themes of cultural anthropology; a field dedicated to the study of social differences. Nature and development of culture utilizing illustrated data drawn from literate and nonliterate peoples of the world will enhance understanding of the purposes and places of humans in the world.
