Description

Mastery of the written word is essential for communication in today's global world. BSC English courses provide students the opportunity to strengthen their writing, reading, and critical thinking skills. English faculty strive to instill in students an appreciation of the power and beauty of the written word and the knowledge that their voices have value, all while participating in a community of active learners. If students want to live in a world of ideas, they should major in English.

The English program serves BSC students in numerous ways. The composition sequence fulfills graduation requirements in Communication. Most 200-level English courses fulfill requirements for Arts and Humanities and Diversity credit, and for students pursuing the BSC English transfer pathway, BSC provides the first two years of study toward a bachelor's degree.

Through assorted groups and activities, students have opportunities as freshmen and sophomores that are often reserved for juniors and seniors at other schools. Involvement in beyond-the-classroom activities, such as the student-produced newspaper and literary journal, gives students experience with practical applications of communication and leadership skills.

Preparation

Literature, journalism, and foreign language classes are useful to high school students pursuing studies in English. Individuals entering this field also will benefit from broad knowledge in history, the arts, world culture, philosophy, psychology, science, and technology.

Requirements

Those completing the suggested curriculum requirements receive an Associate in Arts degree.

Bismarck State College has many cooperative, articulation, or transfer agreements with postsecondary institutions both inside and outside of the North Dakota University System.
